- MAPP Phase 4 (<u>Identifying & Prioritizing Issues</u>): The Partners used the data findings by key issue to identify, develop and prioritize a list of strategic health-related issues facing the community. This process included the development of a list of the most significant health issues identified during the CHNA process, which was used during a nominal objective voting process by workgroup members. The Partners completed a ranking exercise for each issue identified, giving a score to the three prioritization criteria of: (i) magnitude of problem, (ii) seriousness of consequence, and (iii) feasibility of correcting. Scores for each issue were compiled to yield an average score, which was used to rank order the final priorities. Based on the highest scores, the top eight CHNA issues were prioritized as:

1. C	Chronic disease	26.4
2. N	1ental health/trauma	24.0
3. D	Prug dependency/abuse	23.7
4. C	Dbesity	23.3
5. P	Preventive medicine	23.3
6. A	Access to care	22.4
7. T	obacco use/vaping	21.6
8. Y	outh unintentional/intentional injury	21.0
